

## Maya the Bee and NABU - together for insect protection

NABU has been committed to the protection of insects for years. Insects are indispensable for us humans and the entire natural world - and they need protection. That's why it is important to explain and recommend their protection to our children. Maya the Bee has been committed to this since 2018 as part of the initiative "Maya the Bee - Project Poppy Meadow". It wants to continue to inform parents and their children about bees in a playful way and show them what they can do to protect the insects. Planting tips and handicraft instructions for nesting aids encourage children to participate and child-oriented explanations make the importance of biodiversity and the sustainable use of nature understandable.
